The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
The institution shall maintain & update its Website as per provision of NCTE Regulation, 2014.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulation and Order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

12. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website <u>www.ncte.gov.in</u> within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
